COVID-19 Information

Reduced capacity: 20 places

Opening from July 2 to October 4, 2020

For current health reasons, the refuge cannot accommodate you under normal conditions.

A reservation is required to be able to benefit from the refuge's services during the day and in the evening, everyone must also have their signed "Individual commitment charter" (available on the site: www.refuge-lasoula.com to be given to the caretaker or to return by email with his reservation).

Residents of the shelter must bring their down, slippers, pillow, masks, hydroalcoholic gel.

Each person must bring down their own waste.

Dogs are not allowed in the refuge.

It is compulsory to wear a mask inside the premises of the refuge.

Each hiker must wash their hands before entering the refuge, before and after the meal, before and after going to the toilet, smoking, blowing their nose ...

Store your shoes in the lockers, separated from other shoes (not piled up)

The refuge is accessible from 6 p.m. for residents.

Grouping is prohibited inside the refuge.

A physical distance of 1m must be applied in the refuge.

In the dormitories the wearing of a mask is compulsory to cross the rooms.

In the corridors, to avoid crossings, check that nobody goes up or down before committing. Grouping prohibited. Wearing a mandatory mask.

The toilets are closed during the day (except people who have reserved) / There are no showers.

The meals served inside the refuge in the evening are only reserved for people who have reserved one night (two services of 10 people maximum). "Camper" meals are served outside or to take away (bring your bowl).
