

Charter for a stay in a mountain refuge
safe, for me and for others

In the health context linked to COVID-19, the individual responsibility of everyone to limit the effects of pandemic is fundamental. This is also the case in the mountains, and more particularly in a refuge. The guardians and shelter owners have adapted the organization and operation of shelters for you welcome in the best possible conditions. Compliance by each of the measures and protocols put in place is essential.

I certify:

- Be aware that in the current health context, the functioning, reception conditions and services offered by the shelter will not be the same as usual;
- Have taken note of the specific material that I must bring accordingly for me and for my group to be able to stay in the refuge ... (personal protection and disinfection equipment, bedding, down, personal linen...).

- Be aware that failure to comply with health instructions may result in the cancellation of my reservation by the guard to ensure the safety of as many people as possible in the face of the epidemic.

I also agree:

- Do not go to a refuge if someone in my group or I have symptoms potentials of COVID-19 (cough, fever > 37.8 ° C, diarrhea, nausea, cold, severe fatigue, conjunctivitis, loss of taste or smell);
- To respect the conditions of my reservation (number of people, composition of the group, number of overnight stays, type of service (bivouac or dormitory), time of arrival and meal ...);
- To wash my hands with soap before entering the shelter;
- To respect barrier gestures (physical distancing, hand disinfection, wearing a mask, sense of movement in buildings, etc.) and the rules of life in a refuge which have been adapted to each refuge and

presented in the specific health protocol available on the refuge's website and presented by the guard on my arrival;

- To bring all the appropriate equipment necessary for the health safety of my group if necessary and of myself (hydroalcoholic gel, mask, ...) in addition to the classic equipment necessary for my safety in the mountains;
- To take care of all the equipment used during my stay and everything when I leave the refuge particularly the single-use protections used when sleeping
