COVID-19 Information

Open from June 19 to September 25, 2021

For current health reasons, the refuge cannot accommodate you under normal conditions.

A reservation is required to be able to benefit from the services of the refuge in the evening, everyone must also be aware of the "Individual commitment charter visible on the site: www.refuge-lasoula.com.

Residents of the refuge must bring their sleeping bag, slippers, pillow, masks, hydroalcoholic gel.

Each person must bring down their own waste.

Dogs are not allowed at the shelter.

Wearing a mask is compulsory (from 11 years old, recommended from 6 years old) inside the premises of the refuge.

Each hiker must wash their hands before entering the refuge, before and after eating, before and after using the toilet, smoking, blowing their nose ...

Store your shoes in the lockers, separate from other shoes (not stacked).

Groupings are prohibited inside the refuge. A physical distance of 1m must be applied in the refuge.

Decree n ° 2021-699 of June 1, 2021:

Article 1:

In order to slow the spread of the virus, the hygiene measures defined in appendix 1 to this decree and social distancing, including physical distancing of at least one meter between two people, known as barriers, defined at national level, must be observed. in any place and in any circumstance.

III. - In the absence of wearing a mask, and without prejudice to the rules which make it compulsory, the distance mentioned in I is increased to two meters.

In the dormitories it is compulsory to wear a mask to cross the rooms.

In the corridors, to avoid crossings, make sure that no one is going up or down before entering. Grouping prohibited.

Wearing a mask is compulsory.

The toilets are closed during the day / There are no showers.
